



**Danger**  
Causes severe skin burns and eye damage. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/face protection. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water/shower. IF INHALED: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. IF SWALLOWED: rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting.

This disinfectant product has been approved for disinfection of inanimate surfaces where an approved product is required to be used under the control legislation for the following specific disease(s) orders:

- \* Foot-and-mouth disease at the dilution rate of one part of this preparation plus 550 parts of water.
- \* Swine vesicular disease at the dilution rate of one part of this preparation plus 150 parts of water.
- \* Poultry diseases including avian influenza, influenza of avian origin in mammals, Newcastle disease, paramyxovirus at a dilution rate of one part of this preparation plus 99 parts of water.
- \* Tuberculosis disease at a dilution rate of one part of this preparation plus 20 parts of water.

This disinfectant product has also been approved at a dilution of 1 part of this preparation plus 50 parts water for disinfection of inanimate surfaces where General Orders require the use of an approved disinfectant, but this approval does not apply to disinfection required under the specific control legislation relating to Foot and Mouth disease, Swine Vesicular disease, Tuberculosis disease or Diseases of Poultry (Newcastle disease and Avian influenza). This approval is granted under the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Orders made by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in England, Scottish ministers in Scotland and Welsh ministers in Wales. The contents of this container are guaranteed by the manufacturer to be of the same composition and quality as the sample submitted for approval testing.

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Foot Dip application: Remove gross soiling from surface of boot - use at 2%, replace daily. Keep fields covered when not in use.

For Surface disinfection: Remove gross soiling. Apply with a pressure washer or via foam lance at a rate of 300ml/m<sup>2</sup>. Ensure all surfaces are thoroughly wetted.

For disinfection under the UK control legislation for specific diseases please follow the approved dilution rates shown in the enclosed box on this label.

**STORAGE & HANDLING:**  
Store in tightly closed original container. Protect from frost. Store below 25°C and out of direct sunlight.

Use Biocides safely. Always read the label and product information before use.
